The Annual report showcases the achievements and glories of our school. We have always been committed to create a conducive environment in the school which helps the young minds to blossom and provide a platform for the holistic development of the student's personality besides generously contributing for the welfare of the under privileged sections.

RESULTS AT A GLANCE :

I wish to begin with our performance on the academic front. Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of our endeavour as educators. We are happy to present the details of the commendable performance of our students in the Board Examinations.

STD. XII Board Examination, March 2019 – School First and Second.

- In Std XII, AISSC Examinations held in March, 2019, from the Science Stream, Yoga Santhoshi secured school first and scored 493/500 and Prajeeth secured second place and scored 488/500.
- In Commerce Stream, Shubham secured school first with 480/500 and Shalini, Varun and Ujwal secured the second place and have scored 477/500.

CENTUM SCORERS

- Eleven students secured Centum in different subjects.
- One in Mathematics, Two in Physics, Four in Chemistry, One in Biology, Three in Computer Science have scored centum.

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SCHOOL SUBJECT TOPPERS

Two students in Business Studies, one in Economics, one in Hindi have scored 99%, one in History has secured 98%, five in English have secured 97% and three in Accountancy have scored 96%.

Out of 418 students, 224 secured 90% aggregate and above in Std. XII Board Examinations.

SUCCESS IN ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

Two hundred and seventeen students (217) of Std. XII, 2018 – 2019 batch cleared the prestigious IIT Mains Examination and 17 have cleared the NEET Examination and many students are successfully pursuing their courses in different IITs, Medical Colleges, NITs and other reputed colleges across the country.

NATIONAL TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION - 2019

50 students from Std. XI have cleared the NTSE stage two examinations.

ALL INDIA SECONDARY SCHOOL EXAMINATION :

525 students have successfully cleared the AISSE March 2019. Nikitaa has secured the school topper position scoring 490/500. Muthumithra and Pranitha secured second place scoring 489/ 500. 22 students secured centum in different subjects. Five in Sanskrit, five in Mathematics, two in Science and ten in Social Science have secured Centum.

SCHOOL STRENGTH

- Kindergarten has a school strength of 830 and a staff strength of 60.

FIELD TRIPS :

Visakapattinam with 13 teachers, 204 middle school students to Odisha, 14 students to Malaysia for study exchange programme and 15 students to Singapore.
